

Kansas 4-H Horse Show Exhibitor's Preparation Information

4-H Horses can enter the Kansas State Fairgrounds at 8 a.m. on September 14. No stalls available until 8 a.m., Thursday, September 14. Check-in begins at 10 a.m.

Required Health Papers

- Current Health Certificates needed (issued within the past 30 days prior to September 13, 2017)
- A negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) test conducted within one year of the show
- Negative Coggins must accompany the health papers

Check-in before entering the Fairground

- All horses must be checked by the officials of The Kansas Department of Agriculture/Kansas Division of Animal Health (KDAH) before entering the Fairgrounds
- Inspection booth located east of the Fairgrounds at the Fairgrounds Water Park. Enter parking lot from Severance Street between 17th Ave. and 23 Ave. Access Severance Street from 17th Avenue
- Daily check-in hours will be 6 a.m. until 10 p.m. Exhibitors should plan to arrive during these hours. If arrival is going to be delayed past 10 p.m. check-in hours due to circumstances beyond exhibitor's control, please call the Highway Patrol at 620-669-3627
- Once inspected and approved, the officials will officially stamp the health papers which will allow for entry onto the Fairgrounds
- The KDAH reserves the right to inspect or test any animals on the Fairgrounds, if necessary.

Pre-ordered Gate Admission Tickets

- Available at the State Fair Check-in on Severance Street

Upon Entering Fairgrounds

- Horse Stall assignments given at the Stalling Office located south end of Expo II. Once stall given will be directed to stall
- Show check-in table located next to the announcer's stand – double check classes and horse identification papers. If showing a two-year old snaffle bit or three-year old have information available (if entered in those classes)

Show Day

- Check-in with the gate person prior to each class
- Exhibitor conflicts must visit with the Horse Events Coordinator or 4-H Horse Superintendents.

A maximum of **three** horses per 4-H'er may be brought to the State show, regardless of the number qualified at district. Only one halter horse per 4-H'er may be shown at state show. **Please return this form to your local Extension Office** so they may verify or enter the information on the 4-H data entry system. Your Extension Office will then forward this form and the fees to the State 4-H Office, 201 Umberger, 1612 Claflin, KSU, Manhattan, KS 66506-3404 by August 1. **No Late fees accepted. Statement of Humane Treatment of 4-H Horses

All participants in the Kansas State Fair 4-H Horse Show must sign this form.

By signing this statement, I attest that I **have not and will not** use on my horse, any type of medication that has not been prescribed by a licensed veterinarian for a specific medical condition. This includes, but is not limited to, sedatives, tranquilizers, "pain blockers," or any other substance that would alter the behavior or movement of the horse. Further, I attest that no treatment to inhibit the movement of my horses' tail has been employed. I understand that by attesting to this statement I gain the right to show my horse(s) during the **State 4-H Horse Show**, and that if I have violated this statement I forfeit my right to show my horse during the State 4-H Horse Show.

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Parent Code of Conduct for the Kansas State Fair 4-H Horse Show

As a parent of a child participating in the Kansas State Fair 4-H Horse show, you have a responsibility of representing your child, yourself and Kansas 4-H to the public. Therefore, with these responsibilities, you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to your child, yourself, and 4-H (locally and statewide). To do that, you must:

- 1) Conduct yourself in a manner that is trustworthy, respectful, responsible, fair, caring and in good citizenship.
- 2) Be responsible for your actions by following the rules and being accountable.
- 3) Treat your child, yourself, other people, animals and property with respect, using good manners, dressing appropriately and by not using profanity. You will be personally responsible for any damage caused as a result of your behavior.
- 4) Demonstrate caring for people other than yourself. Know that harassment of any type is illegal and prohibited at all 4-H events. Practice good sportsmanship behavior.
- 5) Be a good citizen by helping those around you have positive experiences.
- 6) Use technology, cameras and social media in safe and appropriate ways for the good of 4-H Youth Development programs.

I have read the Code of Conduct above and agree to abide by these expectations. I realize my failure to do so may result in a loss of privilege for myself or child, a dismissal from the Kansas State Fair 4-H Horse Show, and the loss of the ability to participate in future 4-H Horse activities.
