Please try and sell the books your leaders checked out at the Council meeting before requesting additional books. We are being asked to not have as many non-sold ducks within books when we turn them back in.

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May 1 is the deadline for several 4-H things.

- **Horse Id papers** These must be on the October, 2017 form. Form must be front/back. It will not be accepted on two separate pages. We will make a copy at the office and the original will be returned to you.
- **Heart of Kansas Camp registration** If you are interested in attending this summer camp June 11-14, registration is due May 1 into our office along with your registration fee.
- Drop/Add Deadline for projects If you want to drop a project or add a project for this 4-H year, you must do this online by May 1.
- Market Beef nomination forms for KJLS and State Fair are due May 1.

#### County Fair, July 18-22....

Some minor changes for the county fair book rules/schedule. The Fair Book will be posted soon on our website.

- ⇒ Poultry entered at the Fair must be tested prior to Fair. The testing date for Ford County has been set for July 9 at 5:30 p.m. at the Fairgrounds.
- ⇒ Sheep and Goats can be braced, but must be shown with all four feet on the ground. Prior to the class starting, members will be reminding of the rule. If caught breaking this rule, participant will be dropped to the bottom of the class, a second infraction may result in a disqualification.

# **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED...**FAIR SUPERINTENDENTS

What is a SUPERINTENDENT? A Superintendent is someone who assists judges during entry day on July 18th. They also assist in creating the display for the project area. We encourage Livestock Superintendents to assist with their respective livestock weigh-in and out in the ring during the show. These are great leadership activities for your record book!

If you will need us to come tag any livestock, please make those arrangements as soon as possible. We are gone most of June at different camps, so the sooner you get this done, the better!

#### **INSECT SPECTACULAR**

Beetles, bugs, dragonflies and more! It's time to get registered for the 27<sup>th</sup> Kansas 4-H Insect Spectacular, which will be held Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup> and Saturday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will be hosted by the <u>Kansas Wetlands Education Center</u>, located northeast of Great Bend on Highway 156. Learn about collecting, storing, identifying, and pinning your insects for exhibit. All levels of experience are encouraged to attend, from beginning to advanced. This is a fun event, designed to encourage curiosity and the sharing of knowledge. This year's event will feature several sessions specifically on aquatic insects! The workshop is open to all youth and adult



volunteers interested in 4-H entomology. One parent from each family must register and attend with children.

The \$65 registration fee includes lunch and snack Saturday, bottled water, class materials, t-shirt and handouts. Younger siblings under 4-H age, spouses, etc. that may be coming along, but not participating in the classes will need to pay a fee of \$25.00. # SCROGGINS STATE 4-H CAMP/ EVENT SCHOLARSHIP

All 4-H'ers of Ford and Gray County have the opportunity to apply for the Scroggins State 4-H Camp/Event Scholarship. Campers wishing to attend a State 4-H Camp (i.e. Discovery Days, Campference, KYLF, Sewing Camp, etc.) are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Those interested in applying for a Scroggins Camp Scholarship, must fill out the 'Scroggins State Camp/Event Scholarship Application' by the Camp Registration Deadline. <u>No more than one</u> <u>scholarship may be received per 4-H'er/per 4-H</u> <u>year (October 1—Sept. 30)</u>. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications are available on ford.ksu.edu under the 4-H tab or at the Extension Office.

#### **BLAKE STANLEY SCHOLARSHIP**

If you are planning to attend 4-Clover Camp, we encourage you to apply for **one of five \$35 scholarships provided by the Blake Stanley Memorial 4-H Scholarship fund**.
