



July Record Book Tip Sheet



There are sections of the KAP that are optional, however if you want to submit a competitive KAP, you should not skip any section. Each section focuses on an important aspect of your project, so don't miss the opportunity to show off what you did this year!

- Section 2B of the 10-18 Year Old's KAP is optional, but it's an important part of the KAP. Every project has some expense and by filling in this section, it shows the judges that you've kept accurate records and receipts related to your project. If you bought any cooking ingredients, art supplies, livestock feed, equipment, entry fees, ect., this is where you will report that.
- If you exhibited in your project at the county fair, you should have some income to report as well. You can list your ribbon premiums, premium from the livestock sale, income from selling anything related to the project throughout the year, ect.
- Section 2C of the 10-18 Year Old's KAP is also optional, but a great way to make your KAP unique. Below are just some ideas of the charts you can make related to your project. Be sure to keep these sections specific to the project area you're doing your KAP on!
