

# Ford County Fair Overnight Stay – Permission Form



**Only Ford County 4-H members, siblings, parents, leaders, and alumni have expressed permission to stay overnight at the Ford County Fairgrounds.**

4-Her's who plan to stay overnight during the Ford County Fair, to care for their livestock, are responsible for having this form completed and turned into the Extension – 4-H Office by 8:00 pm on Thursday (the week of the Fair). **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!**

All 4-Her's must have a 4-H adult chaperone stay with them, who will be responsible for their safety and behavior. One parent will be responsible for NO more than seven (7) 4-Her's. A sibling over 18 may sign up to stay only with his/her siblings. **All 4-Her's and youth without permission to stay must leave the Ford County Fairgrounds by midnight.**

The Ford County Fair Board and Extension staff will NOT be responsible for supervising youth staying overnight.

## KANSAS 4-H CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in the Kansas 4-H program, you have the responsibility of representing Kansas 4-H to the public. You are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to you, your family, and 4-H. To do that, you must:

1. Conduct yourself and your project work in a manner that is trustworthy, respectful, responsible, fair, caring, and in good citizenship.
2. Be responsible for your actions by following the rules and being accountable. This includes being in assigned program locations/sessions, abiding by deadlines, times, and housing arrangements. If you are unable to participate or need assistance, notify the event/program organizers.
3. Treat yourself, other people, animals, and property with respect, using good manners, dressing appropriately, and by not using profanity. You will be personally responsible for any damage caused as a result of your behavior. Know that the use of tobacco, alcohol, and non-prescribed drugs by youth is illegal.
4. Demonstrate caring for people other than yourself. Know that harassment of any type is illegal and prohibited at all 4-H events.
5. Be a good citizen by participating fully and helping those around you have positive experiences.
